



WRISTBANDS

Wristbands are required for access to event venues. Pick them up at the Merch/Info Booth, or simply jump in line at any Meet & Greet, and door attendants will be happy to assist you. Have your e-ticket ready for scanning.

MEET AND GREETS

Meet Little House cast members in four designated buildings throughout the park (see map). Each location has its own line and a sign listing the cast members inside. Follow the guidance of our friendly line hosts—they're here to keep things running smoothly and ensure everyone has a great experience. Be mindful not to wait on boardwalks or block business entrances. Meet & Greets end promptly at 5:00pm on Friday and Saturday, and at 4:30pm on Sunday. Lines will be cut off about an hour before closing based on estimated capacity. Guests beyond the cutoff point may not reach the cast. Please plan accordingly.
